Subject: PAINT BOOTH SKIMMINGS

Tony;

I have spoken further with facility personnel regarding the bucket of paint waste found in the SM-38 paint booth, and now have a more complete answer to the way this waste is managed. I spoke with Tony Gutierrez, who as the Supt. of Facility Maintenance is Earl Bookwalter's supervisor, and Tony says that Earl provided NMED with an incorrect answer during last week's inspection. As Tony is more familiar with the day-to-day operations of the paint shop, he wanted a chance to set the record straight with regard to what happens to the subject paint waste once it is skimmed from the trough of the water curtain. According to Tony, the bucket into which the skimmings are placed is emptied at the end of each day into a drum in the <90 day storage area located there in the paint shop. Tony has expressed an interest in speaking with a representative of NMED in hopes of clearing up any misunderstanding regarding this waste management, if you feel it appropriate. Like Earl, JENV was unaware of this practice, and is requesting guidance as to whether it is acceptable. You have my number, and Tony can be reached directly at 7-4231. Thanks,
