**SUBJECT: TA-55 APPARENT FINDINGS FROM THE ANNUAL RCRA
INSPECTION OUT-BRIEFING**

This memo is in response to your memo ESH-DO-94-647-11 on apparent findings identified during the out-briefing on 9/22 and 9/23/94 from the annual RCRA inspection by the State of New Mexico Environment Department. A list of the three findings is attached.

A portable eyewash station has been purchased and will be setup for use on the TA-55 storage pad on 10/4/94 to answer the finding that an eyewash station was not within a reasonable distance of the hazardous waste storage area.

The box of fluorescent light bulbs on the pad did not have an accumulation start date. This date was determined and added to the hazardous waste sticker on the box (2/24/94) the day of the inspection.

The five-gallon nalgene bottle in the TA-55 basement mixed waste storage area was hand labeled as hazardous waste, but did not have an accumulation start date. This date was determined and was written on the bottle (1/3/94) the day of the inspection.

- * TA-55, Pad 4 - Interim Status Unit - NMT-2 - There was not an eyewash station within a reasonable distance (100'). **(moderate)**
- * TA-55, Pad 4 - Interim Status Unit - NMT-2 - Florescent bulbs were being stored in a box marked hazardous waste and dated 2/24/94. **(major)**
- * TA-55, Basement - Cabinets - NMT 2 - A five gallon container was present without labels or dates. **(major)**
