SUBJECT: APPARENT FINDINGS FROM THE ANNUAL RCRA INSPECTION

The CST Chemistry Facilities had two apparent findings from the recent RCRA inspection. My comments on these findings are:

TA48-46-101 (CST-10) An open container with acid wipes in it was found. (Major finding).

This violation was corrected on the spot. The generator was counseled by the waste management coordinator. To prevent future occurrences we will continue to provide education for the generators, and maintain a proactive schedule of inspections of areas where waste is generated.

TA21-3-362 (CST-3) This satellite accumulation point was found not to be under the control of the generator. (Major finding).

This was a waste container sitting in a properly labeled satellite storage area, on top of a locked cabinet.

The violation was corrected on the spot. The container was placed in the locked cabinet. Generators who use this satellite storage area were counseled. To prevent future occurrences we will continue to provide education for the generators, and maintain a proactive schedule of inspections of satellite storage areas.
