At this <90-day storage location, a drum was found without an accumulation start date. This is considered a major violation.

The date that the drum was placed in the storage area was entered in the contents manifest, where we record the date, size and type of container, container contents, and date of pickup. The employee and I were both fully aware of that policy before the inspection, and it should not have been overlooked. I am responsible for the daily inspections of the area, and I should have caught and corrected the error.

The drum was subsequently dated during the inspection, and has since been disposed of. The <90 day storage area has been boldly posted with a reminder of the policy. This error will not be repeated.

We will continue to manage our waste operations to the best of our ability, and we will consult with ESH-19 on waste issues and training.
