Subject: Request for Meeting to Discuss Rubble Pile/Compliance Order HRM-98-03

The Department of Energy (DOE) requests to meet with representatives from the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Surface Water Quality Bureau (SWQB), the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB), and the Solid Waste Bureau (SWB) to discuss solutions for regulatory issues pertaining to the Rubble Pile Road Crossing. The meeting is tentatively scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m. on August 11, 1998, at the Los Alamos County Municipal Building, County Council Chambers, at 2300 Trinity Drive in Los Alamos.

DOE proposes to conduct the meeting in two portions in order to attempt to address all issues associated with the Rubble Pile. The first portion of the meeting will convene at the County Building so that Los Alamos County, which holds a Special Use Permit for operation of the Los Alamos County Landfill, can present plans for stabilization of the Rubble Pile. A tour of the Rubble Pile site will conclude the first meeting segment. In addition to NMED, the Army Corps of Engineers will attend the first portion of the meeting.

The second portion of the meeting will be held to address issues associated with Compliance Order HRM-98-03 and will convene at DOE's Los Alamos Area Office after the tour of the Rubble Pile Road Crossing.
