

Re: Compressed Gas Cylinders

Dear Mr. Potts:

As you know, I have sent correspondence to Allyn Davis and Joe Schultes of your office, and have had numerous discussions with Mr. Schultes seeking the EPA's position on an MG Industries proposal to utilize certain compressed gas cylinders, some of which will come out of entities located within the jurisdiction of EPA Region 6. Confirming our telephone conversation this morning, MG's reply letter from EPA Region 6, concerning the above, will direct MG to seek approval of its proposal from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources (PADER), inasmuch as PADER is an authorized RCRA state agency and MG's headquarters and cylinder facility are located in Pennsylvania. In addition, the reply letter will indicate that, assuming MG receives the necessary approval, EPA Region 6 will not oppose entities within its jurisdiction (i.e. Los Alamos National Laboratories) from sending compressed gas cylinders to MG in accordance with our proposal.

I appreciate your assistance in this matter, especially in light of Joe Schultes absence from the office for the next couple weeks. I'll look forward to receiving MG's reply letter next week. Thank you.
