Proposed Sampling at Los Alamos for 2001 Calender Year

Surface Water Samples: Spring melt surface water samples in Pueblo, LA, Pajarito, Canon de Ville.

Mud Flats in Cochiti Lake: Core samples.

Intermediate Wells: All in LA and Pueblo.

Production Wells: Seven, should include O-1.

R-Wells: R-9, R9i, R-12, R-25, R-19, R-31, R-15, R-7, CDV-R15-3, and R-22. Completion zones will be selected later.

Test Wells: All in Mortandad and Los Alamos Canyon.

Mortandad Alluvial Wells: 7 selected wells.
