DATE: March 19, 1987

On this date I gave the attached briefing to the LoWV chapter at White Rock. Contact Janie O'Rourke at (505) 672-1489. I briefed on the evolution of RCRA and the permit process, then into the LANL interim status and permit application, concluding with the incinerator. I was followed by Wayne Hansen of LANL who briefed on the incinerator history, purpose, operation and efficiency.

The audience of about 20 people then asked questions, mostly about radioactive releases from the lab. One question addressed the completeness of the data in the environmental reports. The program to identify old disposal sites was discussed and I explained that would be included in the permit under the HSWA authority. One lady was concerned about transportation accidents off site and we discussed the DOT accident statistics and how to calculate accident occurrences.

There was one reporter from the Rio Grande Sun, two students from the local UNM campus taking an environmental course, several lab employees who were interested in the permitting process and the incinerator and approximately ten citizens.
