Dear Ms. Fort:

Your staff has requested a tour of all the Laboratory's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permitted outfalls and associated contributing sources during the Spring of 1987. Because of the programmatic impacts and associated security requirements, I must require that only personnel with Security ("Q") clearances be allowed on the tour.

It is expected that the tour will take over 20 days to complete and in so doing 50 to 75 buildings located at 30 Technical Areas throughout the Laboratory complex may be inspected. In an effort to minimize interruptions of such an inspection by your staff and still continue essential Laboratory operations, it becomes imperative that only cleared personnel participate in the inspection.

The Department of Energy did anticipate that such a problem would arise a number of months ago and arranged that "Q" clearances be processed for a number of your staff members. Would you please provide the names of individuals that are "Q" cleared who will be participating in this exercise. }
