RE: Environmental Improvement Board Request

As you are aware, the Environmental Improvement Board (Board) has received a request from the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) and two other interested parties for review of the Director's decision of their Hazardous Waste Management Permit. In accordance with those procedures outlined in Section 902.G.2 of the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations the Board would need to render a decision denying, modifying, or sustaining the Director's decision, along with findings and reasons, within 60 days of the receipt of the appeal requests. The Board has requested copies of all evidence admitted in the record formed at the hearing and all evidence available at the time of the Director's decision in order to render a decision.

In addition, the Board has requested the names and addresses of all parties who participated in the hearings in order to afford them the opportunity to submit proposed findings and reasons, based upon the hearing record, and only on those issues raised in the requests for review. The participants will be required to respond on or before January 29, 1990.

Due to time constraints, the above requested materials and information should be submitted as soon as possible to the Board Secretary, Swani LaCuesta.
