Reference is made to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Operating Permit #NM089001515-1. The State of New Mexico issued a hazardous waste permit jointly to the Department of Energy (DOE) and the University of California (UC) on November 8, 1989 for operation of treatment and storage units at the Los Alamos National Laboratory. Attachment I of the permit mandates solid waste stream characterization and submittal of requested information to the Environmental Improvement Division (EID) on a quarterly basis.

In accordance with Permit Attachment I and a letter from the EID to Harry T. Seasons, Jr., dated December 12, 1990, the DOE and UC have enclosed for submittal the required summary reports for the first four quarters covering Technical Areas (TAs) 0-15, 60, 61, and 69. Technical Areas that are no longer in existence (i.e., TAs 1, 4, 7, 10, 12, and 13) are not included in these summary reports. In addition, TA-6 is not included because there is no waste generated in this area.

I have also enclosed a map delineating newly designated TAs (i.e., those in the 60 and 70 series) as requested by yourself and Dr. Elizabeth Gordon.
