FACT SHEET - LANL INSTALLATION WORKPLAN

- The LANL Installation Workplan (IW) is required by HSWA permit condition VIII.D. This Workplan is updated yearly and this is the second IW submitted to EPA, with the first one submitted November 1990 and was approved February 1991.
- The Installation Workplan contains laboratory-wide descriptions of the current conditions, tabular summaries of the potential release sites, prioritization of sites, and a estimated work schedule 5 years in advance. The IW is intended to give EPA information on upcoming actions/work, estimated schedules, and projected funding needs at LANL.
- The IW is not a site/SWMU specific RFI workplan. The site specific workplans are due annually in May. The first site specific workplan was approved on January 9, 1992.
