
Dear Mr. Taylor:

EPA DETERMINATION OF FINAL DECISION ON CLASS 3 PERMIT MODIFICATION

Pursuant to the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a final determination on a Class 3 permit modification to Module VIII of the Los Alamos National Laboratory's permit to operate under RCRA. This modification became effective on May 23, 1994. The EPA has approved the following changes:

- minor wording clarifications and the addition to the current permit of boilerplate language pertaining to dispute resolution in order to provide consistency with other permits in EPA Region 6;
- addition of 473 solid waste management units to the existing 603 for a total of 1076 solid waste management units subject to investigation pursuant to Sections 3004(u) and 3004(v) of RCRA; and
- a staggered schedule for work plans submitted in 1993 and additional schedules for work plans to be submitted in July 1994 and July 1995.
