The New Mexico Environment Department has completed a review of the Los Alamos National Laboratory RCRA and HSWA Permits and compared the information on active units at LANL, provided by LANL's Waste Management Division, and Potential Release Site (PRS) Numbers provided by LANL's Environmental Restoration Division. NMED's review indicates that there are 149 PRS Numbers that are not included in any of the above mentioned information. Enclosed is a list of these numbers that are not included but eluded to by skips in sequence numbers.

Your prompt submittal of this information will allow NMED and LANL to make decisions based on a common database. NMED requests that these PRS numbers have the missing information, indicated by blank spaces in the spreadsheet, provided within the next thirty (30) days. LANL does not have to complete column 2, RCRIS Seq. No., because that number will be provided by EPA's RCRIS Database.
