This letter transmits three documents that were originally submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 as required by the Los Alamos National Laboratory's Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Operating Permit, Module VIII, Section C. The Laboratory believes it has fulfilled special permit condition C.1, Perched Zone Monitoring, with the submittal of the first document listed below and with subsequent monitoring and documents requested by EPA Region 6. The Laboratory has completed the special permit condition C. 8, Identification and Summary of Previous Studies, with the second document listed below. Special permit condition C.6, Vertical Extent of Saturation, was completed with the submittal of the third document listed below.


