Please announce over the radio, between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday, March 10, 1997 through April 23, 1997, the following public service announcement:

The New Mexico Environment Department is proposing to approve a Class 2 Modification to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit to Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). The effects of the modifications will be:

- (1) add language and a table of identified off-site facilities to allow LANL to receive waste or waste residuals derived from the treatment of mixed waste originally generated on-site at LANL.
