Dear Dr. Browne and Mr. Taylor:

This letter responds to LANL's May 11, 1999 and July 22, 1999 letters, Request for Class 1 Permit Modification for Changes to the Environmental Restoration (ER) Project's FY99 Work Schedule (referenced by EM/ER:99-124 and 99-181) received by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB). The May 11, 1999 letter requests the removal of RFI Reports for MDA B (21- 015), MDA U (21-017(a, b, c) and MDA AB (49-001(a, b, c) and a change in the due date to RFI Report for 0-017 to be submitted in July 1999. The July 22, 1999 letter requests a change in date for submittal to the TA-73 RFI Report for 73-004(a, b), 73-005, and 73-006 from September 1999 to the first quarter of FY00.

NMED hereby grants the changes to the FY99 Work Schedule for LANL. The TA-73 Report shall be submitted to HRMB by the close of business on January 3, 2000 as per DOE/LANL's request. A notice of the modification must be sent to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government within ninety (90) calendar days after the Director approves the request pursuant to 20 NMAC 4.1.900, 40 CFR 270.42 (a)(ii).
