Dear Dr. Browne and Mr. Taylor:

This letter responds to LANL's November 16, 1999 letter, *Request for Class 1 Permit Modification to Extend IWP Submittal Date* (referenced by E/ER: 99-329) received by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB). The letter requests an extension of the November 23, 1999 submittal date to March 31, 2000. This extension is to accommodate the generation of an accurate annual work plan schedule and allow for the incorporation of the Canyons Core, Material Disposal Areas Core, and Integrated Strategy documents.

NMED hereby grants the extension of the IWP submittal date to March 31, 2000 as per DOE/LANL's request. A notice of the modification must be sent to all persons on the facility mailing list and appropriate units of State and local government within ninety (90) calendar days after the Director approves the request pursuant to 20 NMAC 4.1.900, 40 CFR 270.42 (a)(ii). A fee of \$1,000 has been assessed for review of the document based on the attached Document Review Fee worksheet. Payment is due within sixty days of receipt of this letter. Should the Return Receipt be sent back to HRMB without a date the receipt of fees are due sixty days from

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the date of this letter. **Payment should be made by certified check or money order payable to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) Hazardous Waste Permits Fund 339.** Should an extension of the sixty day period be required, a request should be received by HRMB, a minimum of fourteen calendar days prior to the end of the sixty day period. This is to ensure that the facility receives HRMB's written approval before the expiration of the payment period. Should you disagree with the fee assessed you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20 NMAC 4.2.302.1.
