Dear Mr. Kileing

I tried to e-mail this to you but I must have the wrong address since it was undelivered, so I am writing and faxing this letter instead.

In August 1999 I received a "Notice" concerning the proposed transfer of 10 LANL parcels in various states of contamination, characterization and remediation under the subject Solid and Hazardous Waste permit.

On June 30, 2000 I received another "Notice" dated June 30, 2000 in which LANL/DOE requested approval of a Class III permit modification of the subject permit which would remove nine (9) unidentified Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) from Module VIII.

On August 15, 2000 Neelam Dhawan faxed to me a portion of LA-UR -00-2265 June 2000 ER2000-0197 Permit Modification NFA Proposals consisting of pages iii 1-1 through 1-3 of the Executive Summary and by mail the August 1999 Summary of ER activities to support land transfer pursuant to PL 105-119. consisting of approximately 35 pages.

Finally by letter dated November 14, 2000 I received a further "Notice" that NMED LANL/DOE intends to approve a Class III permit modification of the subject permit which would remove thirty (30) identified Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs).

In order to comment on these matters with any intelligence and understanding it is now abundantly clear that I need a copy of the complete permit and an explanation why certain PRSs mentioned on pages 13; 15; 17; 19 and 31 of the August 1999 ER, which are within the governance of the subject permit, are not listed. Furthermore, I would appreciate your providing me once again with the complete August 1999 ER which I mislaid when I moved my office as well as the entire document of the June 2000 proposal. I would also need to have a copy of the Statement of Basis, the proposed revised Tables A, B & C and the summary of public involvement activities referred to in your November 14, 2000 letter.
