Based on discussions by phone between Dave McInroy and Paul Schumann of Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) and Carl Will of my staff, and in order to expedite submittal of requested information, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is providing the following modification and clarifications to a request for information issued by letter from me to you dated February 12, 2001.

- 1) In lieu of all items in the last paragraph of page three of Attachment A to the February 12 letter, i.e., core logs, flow rates, geophysical reconstructions, foot-by-foot geophysical logging results, fracture density calculations, daily flow rates, and raw geophysical data, NMED requests that LANL submit existing and not previously submitted boring logs, well construction details/schematics, and pilot testing reports for the sites listed in Attachment A.
- 2) Boring logs, well construction details/schematics, and pilot testing reports will constitute a complete submittal under the above-referenced paragraph. Additional items in LANL's Category 3 and "other applicable data results" need not be submitted.


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- 3) Location ID numbers instead of sample ID numbers are acceptable on maps submitted.
