SUBJECT: Crosswalk of Requirements of the Hydrogeologic Workplan and the Order

DATE: March 20, 2003

I have compared the requirements for the installation of monitoring wells in the Hydrogeologic Workplan (HWP) and the LANL Order. As of March, 2003, there are 15 HWP Regional R-wells remaining to be drilled: R-1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 10, 11, 17, 18, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30. All of these wells are listed in the Order either by number (i.e. R-2) or by description, with the exception of well R-29 in lower Water Canyon. However, R-29 should still be installed, because the schedule in Section XII of the Order requires the installation of 15 regional R-wells in the years 2003-2005 (6 in 2003, 5 in 2004, and 4 in 2005). There are also additional deep wells required in the Order and described in the text of the Order that are not included in this list of 15 wells. All of the alluvial and intermediate depth wells required under the HWP are also required in the Order, either directly or through the implementation of the specific canyon workplans.



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
