Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed permit modification to remove several Solid Waste Management Units from the DOE/LANL RCRA operating permit.

I feel removal of these sites from the permit is appropriate.

As a member of the Northern New Mexico Citizens' Advisory Board, I received a briefing on these sites on November 4, 2002, attended a public meeting on November 14, 2002 in Los Alamos, and reviewed the Statement of Basis on your web site. From the nature of these sites, I feel that it is reasonable for NMED to determine that they do not pose a threat to public health or the environment. I feel the determination that no further action is needed is in the public's best interest and that no more public resources need be expended on these sites.
