This list is submitted to satisfy the requirements of Paragraph 21 subparagraphs (a) and (d) of the Agreement.

The attached table lists the buildings or fixed structures scheduled for demolition; historic uses and dates of operation of each building or fixed structure; solid waste management units (SWMUs) or areas of concern (AOC) within 50 feet of each building or fixed structure to be demolished; categories of potential wastes generated from or managed in, each building or fixed structure; and the date or quarter in which the demolition is scheduled.
