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These SWMUs and consolidated units were proposed for NFA in the September 27, 2001, document entitled "Documentation Supporting No Further Action for 18 Solid Waste Management Units" (LA-UR-01-5437). The request for the NFA of these firing sites was based on their exemption from the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) under the military munitions rule. Each of the listed sites are (or were) used exclusively by the Los Alamos National Laboratory as weapons/munitions testing and research sites.

Per negotiated agreement, the sites that would otherwise have been subject to RCRA exemption under the military munitions rule will now be evaluated in accordance with the Consent Order.
