Rebecca,

This memo is to respond to your question about the identification of the nearby Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) in the August 20, 2007 letter transmitting the Proposed Transuranic Waste Facility Class 3 Permit Modification Request. The letter identifies the SWMU as 14-001. This is a typographical error and the SWMU should be identified as "SWMU 04-001," which is consistent with the description in Section 4 of the permit modification request.

The discussion in the letter addresses a supplementary question from the site tour regarding buffer zones from past firing sites in the vicinity of the proposed facility. SWMU 04-001 is a former firing site within approximately 2000 feet from the proposed facility. LANL currently maintains a 2500 foot average radius buffer zone for metal fragments based upon the DOE Explosives Safety Manual and so this site is within that criteria (See page 04-3, Supplement 4.1). SWMU 14-001(a) and (b) are firing sites but are located approximately two miles southwest at Technical Area 14.

We apologize for any inconvenience this matter has caused and look forward to correcting this error through the Notice of Deficiency process as your telephone message suggested.
