James:

Thank you for taking the time to discuss the TA-52 Permit Mod package that LANL submitted in August of 07. As we discussed LANL is unable to respond to the two NODs submitted by NMED. The TA-52 project is too early in its development to provide the level of detail that is needed by NMED to process LANL's permitting request. We appreciate the lengths to which you and your staff have gone to provide LANL with a timely review of its submittal. We will utilize your NODs as a basis for the development of a permit mod to be resubmitted in the future for this facility. LANL would like the opportunity to discuss some of the issues (e.g. seismic concerns) to get a better understanding of NMED's informational needs in this area and at the same time enable LANL to develop a suitable scope of work to conduct the required work. I will follow this email with a formal notice and a request for an indefinite extension for the TA-52 permit mod submittal.
