NOTICE OF FIVE CLASS 1 PERMIT MODIFICATIONS

The National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) and the Los Alamos National Security, LLC (LANS) have submitted five Class 1 permit modifications to the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Hazardous Waste Facility Permit. The modifications were submitted to the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Bureau on December 18, 2007. The permit modifications update Attachment B; Figures 1, 2, 13, D-3 and E.12-1; and Attachment D within the Permit. Brief descriptions of the changes made to the Permit are:

- The inspection record form (Attachment B-1) within the Inspection Plan (Attachment B) was updated and minor organization name changes were made to the plan.
- Figures 13 and E.12-1 were updated to remove portable buildings and sheds not part of the outdoor container storage unit at Technical Area (TA) 54, Building 38 (TA-54 West), because these structures were removed from the area.
- Figures 1, 2, and D-3 have been revised to show the new LANL boundary due to land transfer activities.
- The listing of emergency managers (Table D-2) within the Contingency Plan (Attachment D) has been revised to remove two emergency managers who are no longer functioning in that capacity and to add a replacement.
- Organization names, contact phone numbers, and facility location information within the Contingency Plan (Attachment D) have been updated.

These permit modifications have been prepared in accordance with the New Mexico Administrative Code, Title 20, Chapter 4, Part 1, Subpart IX (20.4.1.900 NMAC) (incorporating Code of Federal Regulations [CFR], Title 40 § 270.42(a)(1)), revised October 1, 2003. The update of the inspection record form does not change the frequency or content of the inspections conducted at the LANL permitted container storage units and is necessary to make the content of inspections consistent at all hazardous waste management units across LANL and decrease the likelihood of errors on the form. Changes to the figures are necessary to accurately depict the structures located in the TA-54 West outdoor container storage unit and the LANL boundary and do not have any impact on the individual boundaries or capacity of the LANL permitted container storage units. Modifications to the Contingency Plan are necessary to comply with 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR § 264.52(d)) and to keep information within the plan current. This public notification of these modifications is in accordance with 20.4.1.900 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR § 270.42(a)(1)(ii)).
