**SUBJECT: REVISED DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT FOR LOS ALAMOS
NATIONAL LABORATORY**

Dear Mr. Hanson:

Enclosed is a **Public Notice** regarding the availability of a revised draft Hazardous Waste Permit for Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) ("revised draft Permit"). The revised draft Permit is the result of discussions with commenters who also requested a public hearing on the August 27, 2007, draft Permit that the New Mexico Environment Department ("Department") made available for public comment. The Public Notice provides the location where the Administrative Record, including the Permit Application, revised draft Permit, Fact Sheet, and supporting documentation, for this action can be reviewed, and provides procedures for submitting comments and requesting a public hearing. It also explains in summary form the New Mexico Environment Department's (Department's) withdrawal of the August 27, 2007 draft Permit, and that comments and requests for hearing on that draft Permit are therefore moot. The notice also provides notification of a public meeting to be held on July 28, 2009 concerning the revised draft Permit. Comments and requests for public hearing on the revised draft Permit must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. MDT, September 4, 2009**.

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
