Dear Ms. Stiger and Mr. Rael:

On May 31, 2007, a representative of Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) notified the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) that the U.S. Department of Energy and Los Alamos National Security, LLC (collectively, the Permittees) had exceeded the 21-day window for sampling base flow in Water Canyon, as required by the March 1, 2005 Order on Consent. Based on the information in the notification, the NMED issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) dated June 1, 2007.

The NMED has reviewed your June 15, 2007 response to the NOV. The NMED acknowledges the steps the Permittees have taken to ensure that water sampling requirements in the Consent Order are complied with in the future. The NMED has determined that the violation cited in the NOV has been adequately addressed, and no further action relative to the NOV is required. Any action taken in response to this letter does not relieve you of your obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
