Subject: Delegation to "Duly Authorized Representatives" pursuant to 40 CFR 270.11 and 40 CFR 122.22

Effective March 22, 2015, the Department of Energy established an Environmental Management Los Alamos Field Office (EM-LA) with the sole purpose of completing the legacy waste cleanup mission at Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL). The newly formed EM-LA will work closely with the National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos Field Office (NA-LA) to ensure safe operations of assigned missions and an integrated and holistic approach to meeting compliance.

This letter delineates responsibilities between the two field offices, and to also notify New Mexico Environmental Department of delegations of authority to sign documents pursuant to 40 CFR 270.11 and 40 CFR 122.22. Kimberly Davis Lebak, as a senior executive officer responsible for the overall operations of a principal geographic unit (NA-LA), will continue to act as the principal signatory with regard to Hazardous Waste Permit NM0890010515. Consistent with the mission of the new EM-LA office, Mr. Douglas Hintze, as a senior executive officer responsible for the overall operations of a principal geographic unit (EM-LA), will act as the principal signatory for the March 1, 2005 Compliance Order on Consent deliverables, and other regulatory documents associated with the legacy waste cleanup.

In light of now having two field offices at LANL and in meeting the stated commitment, we hereby delegate authority to sign reports associated with permits, notices of changed conditions, and other compliance documents and information as required by the New Mexico Environment Department as noted below.

Pursuant to her authority under 20 New Mexico Administrative Code 4.1.900 (40 CFR 270.11) to delegate signature authority to a duly authorized representative, Kimberly Davis Lebak hereby delegates authority to sign all reports and other information requested by the New Mexico Environment Department to the following positions:

Pursuant to his authority under 20 New Mexico Administrative Code 4.1.900 (40 CFR 270.11) to delegate signature authority to a duly authorized representative, Douglas Hintze hereby delegates authority to sign all reports and other information requested by the New Mexico Environment Department to the following positions:


- Supervisor for Soil and Groundwater, EM-LA, currently held by David Rhodes; and

Persons occupying these positions may act as "duly authorized representatives" with the authority to sign reports required by permits and other information required by NMED.


