 SUBJECT: ANNUAL REPORT ON PIT #1, AREA G, FOR 1958.

Pit #1, Area G, was used for receiving non-routine contaminated material in 1958. Buildings from TA-1 which were torn down in 1953 were put into Pit #1. The fire trench in the center of the pit was used to burn wooden material.

Since the material placed in Pit #1 was non-routine and the charges for putting this material in the pit are included in demolition costs it would be difficult to arrive at a cost per cubic yard of material.

Certain fixed costs are tabulated by quarter for 1958 and are shown on attached data sheet. An explanation of these costs are as follows:

Fencing:

Original cost = \$6040.00; write off rate @ 1/10 per year.
 Balance = \$5587.00; 1/4 of \$604.00 = \$151.00 for the fourth quarter and a total of \$604.00 for 1958.

Road Construction And Excavation Of Indian Ruins:

Original cost = \$10872.00; write off rate at 1/20 per year. (\$543.00). 1/4 of \$543.00 = \$135.00 for the fourth quarter and \$543.00 for 1958. The balance remaining at the end of 1958 is (\$10872.00 - \$543.00) = \$10,329.00.

Excavation Of Pit #1:

The original cost (\$12571.75) is being written off at the rate of 1/8 per quarter. This is on the assumption that the pit will be used for two years. For the fourth quarter of 1958 this amounts to \$1572.00. The balance remaining at the end of 1958 is \$3,140.00.
