Aridiculous amount of time was spent at the first of this month determining whether copies of LA-6848-MS, Vols. I and II had been sent to those on the distribution list. It was determined that no copies had been sent outside the laboratory. Copies have now been sent to all those on the distribution list as well as to several others who requested copies. A list is being kept of all who have received copies.

Appendix H of LA-6848, Vol II (Records of Disposals to Area C Shafts) has been completed, typed, and proofed. I am awaiting typing corrections on it. John Booth finished compiling Appendix H during my leave-of-absence.

Roy Bailey, U.S.G.S., was contacted about forwarding information on his work on the Pajarito Plateau. He was to use photographs I sent him to depict his stratigraphic units and identify locations of his measured sections. The information was promised for the end of this month. It has not yet arrived.

Dean Meyer, consultant for H-12, came twice this month to discuss work he did in connection with the LA-6848-MS update during my leave-of-absence. His work has been written-up, typed, corrected, and signed by him. Don Mayfield and I would like him to come again and write down his comments on the efficiency of early radiation detection equipment in order to be able to better evaluate old records.

John Gallimore, C. D. Blackwell, E. J. Cox, and Carl W. Buckland of H-1 and J. W. Enders of H-7 were requested to review LA-6848-MS for corrections and additions for the update. Carl W. Buckland has replied and has written two additional memos on past activities he was acquainted with.

C. W. Christenson, L. A. Emelity, J. R. Buchholz, P. E. McGinnis, and John Warren, all of H-7, have been requested to review certain portions of LA-6848-MS for corrections and additions for the update. None have replied.

I am continuing to work with and adjust the stereo zoom transfer scope in preparation for compiling the geologic map. It may be necessary to have the company representative visit again. He came during my leave-of-absence even though he was requested to delay the visit.

The rest of my time was spent in catching up on my reading and attending two geology seminars.
