Eighteen percent of my time was spent talking with various people on various subjects, 19% was spent writing or reviewing reports, 8% was spent on the mapping project, and 44% was spent on the update of LA-6848-MS. The equivalent of 9% of my time was put in above regular working hours. John Enders was here as a consultant on the update of LA6848-MS January 22-25, 1979.

Work During January 1979 toward objective (1) maintenance of a continuous record of all former and current operational or research activities at the disposal sites.

Quite a bit of effort has been put into tracking down and going through old records which were not used in the original version of LA-6848-MS. Work orders might have answered some questions for the various sites; however, (1) John Enders did not retain them in his files, (2) ENG-4 (Maintenance) does not file work orders, (3) ENG-3 (Records) has only a very few of the many which were issued, and (4) ZIA does not retain them for more than two years and files them by date, not subject. The surveyors in ENG-1 (Construction) keep a log of the jobs they have done going back to about 1956, but the log gives minimal information. Other records which have thoroughly been gone through are:

- (1) H-1 records in the Records Center which give any hint by title of being associated with a waste disposal site,
- (2) John Enders' (formerly of H-1, H-8, and H-7) memos, and
- (3) ENG-3 records on LASL Materials Waste Disposal Sites.

John Enders spent four days answering questions raised by some of the "new" memos found; and in trying to determine the size and dates of drilling, use, and closure of the Area C shafts.

Work during January 1979 toward objective (4) description of the geologic, biologic, and hydrologic pathways by which releases might occur.

Some time was spent in assembling and adjusting the Stereo Zoom Transfer Scope which was recently returned by Bausch & Lomb after repair. Too early to tell whether it really is repaired.
