Nine percent of my time was spent talking with various people on various subjects, 26% was spent writing or reviewing reports, 9% was spent on the geochemistry study, 16% was spent on the mapping project, and 26% was spent on the update of LA-6848-MS. The equivalent of 14% of my time was put in above regular working hours.

Work during February 1979 toward objective (1) maintenance of a continuous record of all former and current operational or research activities at the dipsosal sites.

On February 20, 1979 I stopped work on the update of LA-6848-MS. For 3 1/2 months I have tried to get information for the update and to complete it. I began requesting this information in March 1978. The information needed was either not supplied or not supplied on a very timely basis. If the geologic map is to be complete at the end of FY79, then no more time can be spent on the update. Maxine Lewis tells me it would be several months before she could work on the update if it were available. Therefore, I will complete the update at my convenience at home.

Work during February 1979 toward objective (4) description of the geologic, biologic, and hydrologic pathways by which releases might occur.

Some of the trace element analyses have come in this month. Barry Burton and I have spent time discussing the results to date.

I have been working on Map 17 for the geologic mapping project.
