Sixteen percent of my time was spent talking with various people on various subjects, 4% was spent on the map, 24% was spent on the trace element study, 5% was spent on the horizontal core report, 14% was spent on the joint study, and 5% was spent in moving. The equivalent of 18% of my time was put in above regular working hours. May 15th I attended the Low Level Waste Management Lead Organization Site Visit at LASL. June 28th Barry Burton and I visited with Bill Arnold, drafting department, New Mexico Bureau of Mines, in Socorro and with Basil Pouls of Koogle & Pouls Engineering, Inc. in Albuquerque concerning the drafting of the geologic map. June 11-19 I was at the Mayo Clinic.

During May and June I arranged for Dr. Fred M. Bullard, volcanologist, to be a lab colloquium speaker and consultant for H-12.

Two abstracts were sent to the Geological Society of America for consideration for the Annual Meeting in November: "Distinguishing Structural Joints from Cooling Joints in the Bandelier Tuff (Pleistocene) Pajarito Plateau, Northcentral, New Mexico: A Radioactive Waste Management Study" and "Trace Element Study of the Bandelier Tuff (Pleistocene), Pajarito Plateau, Los Alamos and Santa Fe Counties, Northcentral New Mexico."
