Report

Seventeen per cent of my time was spent talking to various people on various subjects, 16% was spent on the geologic map, 10% was spent on the "index of refraction" study, 1% was spent on the trace element study, 19% was spent on the update of LA-6848-MS, and 19% was spent on discussion or reading for program A415. The equivalent of 5% of my time was put in above regular working hours. On November 7, 1979, I became principal investigator for program A415.

The monitoring activities report for Areas C and G from 1973 to present was finally completed after I spent considerable time this month going through CMB-1's files. In five months they had been unable to find the time to go through their own files to send me the information I needed.

Five meetings were held this month on program A415 plans for the next two years. The following were present at the meetings: 1. those staff members and consultant assigned to program A415, Willy Abeelee, Barry Burton, Virginia Christie, Merle Wheeler, and myself; 2. the group office, Gene Wewerka, Jim Steger, and Caroline Wienke; and 3. H-8 staff members assigned to program A414, Lew Walker and Don Mayfield.

Two days were spent in field checking for Maps 17, 18, 19, 24, 25. I have been drawing geologic contact lines on aerial photographs for these maps.
