

Dear Mr. Garcia:

As requested by your staff, the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) is pleased to provide you with an electronic copy of LANL's 1996 Hazardous Waste Biennial Report, GM form data. As required, a hard copy of the complete report was submitted to your office in February 1996.

The enclosed diskette holds two files, EPA&NM.TXT and README.TXT. The second file, README.TXT, contains information about the format of the data file EPA&NM.TXT. That information is reproduced below.

The file EPA&NM.TXT contains an electronic copy of the data compiled for the GM forms in LANL's 1996 Hazardous Waste Biennial Report. Data for the other forms is not currently available in electronic format.

The data file is a quoted and comma delimited ASCII file. The first row consists of field names that conform to the block labels on the EPA's GM form, in the order they appear, reading from top to bottom and from left to right. Note that blocks on the GM forms may require more than one line of data. In such cases, several data fields may be required to complete the block. An example is the "comment" block which is filled using data fields Comment1, Comment2, and Comment3. This convention was used throughout the data file for several fields.


