

**Subject: 15-Day Notification for the Demolition of the Bayo Wastewater Treatment Plant**

Dear Mr. Bearzi:

Beginning September 8, 2009, Los Alamos County is planning to begin demolition of the Bayo Wastewater Treatment Plant. Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory) will be on-site during ground-breaking activities to observe and monitor for the presence of any contamination potentially associated with past Laboratory activities, as outlined in the Observation Plan for the Demolition of the Bayo Canyon Wastewater Treatment Plant, Area of Concern 00-018(b), by Los Alamos County, dated April 2009. The plan was approved with modifications by the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) in a letter dated April 15, 2009, and further clarified by NMED in a letter dated August 19, 2009.
