**Subject: Request for Certificates of Completion for Two Areas of Concern in the Frijoles Canyon Aggregate Area**

Dear Mr. Bearzi:

In accordance with Section VII.E.6.b of the Compliance Order on Consent (Consent Order), the Los Alamos National Laboratory (the Laboratory) and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) are requesting Certificates of Completion without Controls for the following areas of concern (AOCs) within the Frijoles Canyon Aggregate Area:

- AOC C-00-037, Landfill, Bandelier National Monument
- AOC C-00-038, Surface Disposal Area, Bandelier National Monument


Both sites were recommended for Certificates of Completion in the submittal letter (EP2010-0400) for the report entitled Historical Investigation Report for Frijoles Canyon Aggregate Area (LA-UR-10-6408/EP2010-0400). Both AOCs are located at Bandelier National Monument. The report substantiates that the wastes and materials located at these two AOCs are not associated with Laboratory activities. Because no releases of Laboratory-related contaminants occurred at these sites, they are not subject of further requirements under the Consent Order. Subsequently, neither site controls nor additional future actions under the Consent Order are necessary.

The report was approved in your December 6, 2010, letter Approval, Historical Investigation Report for [the] Frijoles Canyon Aggregate Area (HWB-LANL-10-082).
