Certificates of completion are not required for land transfers. The process for land transfer is spelled out in Consent Order Section III.Y. Section III.Y includes a schedule for each action by the parties so that the process moves forward without extended delays. I have not seen the cover letter for the *Request for Certificates of Completion for one SWMU and one AOC in the Guaje/Barrancas/Rendija Canyons Aggregate Area* but if it included notification of land transfer, we may be able to consider that notification as the start of the process provided that DOE has enough remaining time to meet the other scheduled items.
