

Subject: 15-Day Sampling Notification for Phase II Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area Investigation


Dear Mr. Kieling:

On November 2, 2015, Los Alamos National Laboratory is scheduled to conduct additional soil sampling as part of the continuation of Phase II investigation and remediation activities in the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area. The scope of the sampling is part of ongoing field activities being conducted to meet the objectives of the Phase II Investigation Work Plan for the Upper Los Alamos Canyon Aggregate Area, dated October 21, 2010 (EP2010-0398), and the New Mexico Environment Department approval letter, dated January 19, 2011 (HWB-LANL-10-080).

Sampling activities are expected to last approximately 7 months, from the beginning of November 2015 to the end of May 2016. The sampling results will be presented in the investigation report for this aggregate area.
