This is to advise that two old wooden shacks, identified as TA-0-127 and TA-0-131, located within the subject contaminated pit area, are to be dismantled and buried in Pit Area "C".

The two structures had been previously located in other technical areas, and were moved to the pit area to protect certain contaminated materials from the weather. Since the adjacent Pajarito Road is now a public thoroughfare, we feel it is in the best interests to remove these "eyesores" from the view of the general public; one of the shacks also constitutes an obstruction to vision at a busy intersection, and was recommended to be removed, by a committee studying safety measures. The shacks are contaminated radioactively, and are of little or no value.
