The Agreement in Principle (AIP) program has submitted review comments on the document "Phase Report for OU 1071, SWMU Aggregate 0-G, Leakage from PCB Transformers" to the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB). Although HRMB does not have regulatory authority over PCBs, nor HSWA authority at this time, the Bureau acknowledges that the remediation does appear to meet TOSCA requirements for cleanup of PCBs. Based upon information supplied in the report, HRMB concludes that it is appropriate to nominate SWMU 30-G for no further action (NFA).
