Water Monitoring Issues in Lower Los Alamos Canyon**


Dear Mrs. Webb:

Please find enclosed a copy of the Agreement In Principle (AIP) DOE Oversight Program, February 19, 1993 meeting notes. This meeting, between Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) (EM-8 and EES-1), AIP staff, San Ildefonso Pueblo, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), and All Indian Pueblo Council (AIPC) was held to discuss ground-water monitoring of lower Los Alamos Canyon.

As requested, AIP staff recommended the installation of specific alluvial monitoring-wells to increase our confidence that contaminants are not leaving the Laboratory boundary via the perched-alluvial aquifer system and to provide an "early warning" system for this pathway (Attachment A). The AIP Program has not recieved comment on this issue and would like to be informed as to the intentions of DOE on this matter.
