Subject: Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) Reports and Plans

The Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) would like to coordinate with the DOE Oversight, Ground Water Quality and the Surface Water Quality Bureaus concerning the following LANL RCRA submittals:

- Radiological Addendum to the RFI Report for Potential Release Sites 1-002, 45-001, 45-002, 45-003, 45-004, C-45-001, in Technical Areas 1 and 45, Field Unit 1, March 11, 1996 (EM/ER: 96-115)
- RFI Report for Potential Release Sites 0-030(b), 0-004, 0-010(b), and 0-033(b), 6th Street Warehouses, in Technical Area 0, Field Unit 1, dated May 22, 1996 (EM/ER: 96-271)

The "omnibus" provision of RCRA Section 3005 [40 CFR 270.32] allow the Administrative Authority, HRMB, the flexibility to address all unacceptable risks to human health and the environment from RCRA facilities. Therefore, HRMB encourages and invites the participation of all Bureaus in the review and approval of the above documents. In early June, HRMB intends to transmit comments to LANL regarding these documents. Therefore, comments received prior to July 25, 1997, will be incorporated into HRMBs comments. HRMB appreciates the pro-active participation of the DOE Oversight, Ground Water Quality and Surface Water Quality Bureaus in the regulation of the Department of Energy facilities and looks forward to continued coordination regarding Departmental issues.
