The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the Response to the NOD for the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL) RCRA RFI Report for Potential Release Sites (PRSs) 0-028(a, b), located in Technical Area 0. The document was submitted by LANL, November 15, 1997.

PRS 0-028(a) is the Los Alamos County Golf Course, and PRS 0-028(b) is the North Mesa athletic field. Both are located in the northern portion of Los Alamos County. EPA has determined that the factual information and the analytical results presented in the Response to the NOD and the RCRA RFI Report are acceptable and that those two sites have met the requirements of No Further Action Criteria (NFA) No. 5 (See Annex B, NFA Process and Criteria, "Environmental Restoration Document of Understanding", Revision 0, February 1, 1996). The RFI report recommends NFA at these two sites, and EPA concurs with this recommendation.
