Agreement-In-Principle (AIP) staff has submitted a request to the Department of Energy (DOE) for copies of the letters that DOE sent to private property owners of former TA-1 sites that contain or adjoin SWMU's 1-006(m), and 1-007(h). AIP will review and verify that these letters address AIP comments on the OU-1078 RFI Addendum, specifically that current land owners should have been notified by DOE that SWMU's 1-006(m), and 1-007(h) exist on or near their property. See AIP comments, Item 1, bullet 3 and Item 2, bullet 1 of the AIP review of OU-1078 RFI Work Plan Addendum, NFA Proposals submitted October 1993. Upon review of the letters, AIP staff will report their recommendations to the LANL/ER OU-1078 RFI OUPL and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) regarding this issue.
