Subject: 15-Day Notification for Aquifer (Pumping) Test at Monitoring Well 03-B-10

Dear Mr. Bearzi:

Beginning on or about September 15, 2009, Los Alamos National Laboratory plans to conduct a pumping test at monitoring well 03-B-10 in conjunction with the quarterly groundwater sampling event scheduled for that same timeframe. The purpose of the test is to assess the hydraulic properties of the perched intermediate groundwater zone in the vicinity of building SM-30 at Technical Area 03, near Solid Waste Management Unit 03-010(a) and Area of Concern 03-001(e). The details of the pumping test are outlined in the Work Plan for Proposed Aquifer Test Activities at Monitoring Well 03-B-10, due to the New Mexico Environment Department by September 4, 2009.
