The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the United States Department of Energy (DOE) and the Los Alamos National Security L.L.C.'s (LANS) (collectively, the Respondents) *Buildings or Fixed Structures Scheduled to be Demolished During Fiscal Year 2011*, dated September 23, 2010 and referenced by LA-UR-10-06020 and ENV-RCRA-10-179.

In accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (e) of the April 10, 2007 Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order (Agreement), NMED hereby identifies Building 21-0227, Sewage Treatment Plant, as a structure for which it requires notice of demolition.

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In addition, NMED identifies Buildings 21-0286, 21-0387 and 39-139 as structures for which it requires notices of demolition if hazardous materials were stored in them.

As previously directed in correspondence dated October 7, 2009 and July 16, 2010, notification of demolition activities for structures TA-21-149, TA-21-150, TA-21-152 and TA-21-209 are also required.

In accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (e) of the Agreement the Respondents must submit a notice of commencement of demolition 30 days prior to the start of demolition for each of the above-referenced buildings. In accordance with Paragraph 21 subparagraph (f) of the Agreement, the Respondents must provide a copy of the demolition completion report for each building, if prepared, to NMED within 30 days following completion of the report for each building.
