NMED has received the Permittee's work plan for the extended purging and sampling at R-61 S1 and S2 as attached in your e-mail that was received Thursday, July 11, 2013 at 2:37 pm. At this time, NMED has no comments on the work plan. Please note that NMED will not accept analytical results/data obtained from the sampling at R-61 with reference to applying such data for regulatory purposes or technical representativeness. NMED judges R-61 and other similarly impacted wells such as R-40i, R-54, and R-55i not capable of generating acceptable contaminant detection or monitoring data.
